TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AND RECORD RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT DOCUMENTS RELATED TO WATER LINE INSTALLATION FOR THE BICENTENNIAL BARN AT MCCAMMON CREEK PARK

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners (the "Board") of Preservation Parks of Delaware County (the "District") deem it desirable and in the best interests of the public to provide a permanent Right-of-Way easement on 0.033 acres of parcel number 318-412-01-002-008 to Del-Co Water Company for the purpose of installing and maintaining a water line to the Bicentennial Barn project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is hereby directed and authorized to execute and record all documents required relating to the granting of a right-of-way easement to the Delco Water Company and that these actions are within the authority conferred to the Executive Director.
