**RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS**

1. Is the earthwork balanced?  
*Response: Only with the added fill from Orange Township*
2. When will Orange Township earthwork be available?  
*Response: Current schedule relayed to the Orange Township Contractor is for delivery of the soil to the site in August/September with the firm date to be coordinated with the selected contractor for this project so that it can be delivered to the entry drive/parking lot areas.*
3. Is the contractor responsible for testing cost? Earthwork embankment, proof roll, and bridge foundations, other  
*Response: Per section 31 23 00 of the specifications, earthwork testing is the responsibility of the contractor. Contractor is also responsible for concrete testing per ODOT Item 511, and helical pile testing per the specification section 31 66 15, as noted on Sheet S-002, and ODOT Item 507.*
4. What permits are expected?  
*Response: The Engineer has been in discussions with and is submitting for approval from Delaware County and Orange Township for the following:*
  - *Stormwater Management Approval*
  - *Bridge Structural*
  - *Driveway Installation*
  - *Crosswalk Approval*

*A Notice of Intent (NOI) for coverage under the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency general construction stormwater National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit will also be submitted. The Contractor shall be responsible for submitting the Co-Permittee form prior to commencement of site activities.*

*The Contractor shall be responsible for preparing and submitting for approval to the County and Township a Maintenance of Traffic Plan for work within the Bale-Kenyon right of way.*
