AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR CLEAN OHIO GREENSPACE CONSERVATION PROGRAM FUNDING

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), administers financial assistance for land acquisition and greenspace protection, through the Clean Ohio Greenspace Program Fund; and

WHEREAS, The Preservation Parks of Delaware County (the "District") desires financial assistance from the Clean Ohio Green Space program to acquire approximately 96 acres of property, more or less, located in Genoa and Harlem Townships and desires; and

WHEREAS, this property contains headwaters of Big Walnut Creek, and this acquisition would present the District with the opportunity to conserve these headwater streams; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of Preservation Parks of Delaware County (the "Board") deems this purchase desirable for the preservation and development of parkland and to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board as follows:

- 1. That the Board approves filing an application for Clean Ohio Greenspace Conservation Program financial assistance.
- 2. That Natural Resources Manager, Chris Roshon is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with OPWC and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
- 3. That Executive Director, Mary Van Haaften is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
- 4. That the District agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Clean Ohio Greenspace program.
