

Resolution # 2025-621

ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners (the "Board") placed on the November 2017 ballot a .9 mill levy, effective January 1, 2018, for the collection during 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Board placed on the November 2021 ballot a .4 mill levy, effective January 1, 2022, for collection during 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, 2029, 2030, 2031; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Delaware County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to the Board together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate each tax necessary to be levied by this Board, and what part thereof is without, and what part is within, the ten-mill tax limitation,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Preservation Park District of Delaware County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification be approved, and the same be hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said County the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:

Park District Levy Fund: \$12,015,851 outside the 10-mill limit for the tax year 2025.

TO AUTHORIZE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PRESERVATION PARKS OF DELAWARE COUNTY AND THE CENTRAL OHIO COLLABORATIVE FOR CONSERVATION

WHEREAS, the Preservation Park District of Delaware County (the "District") has an opportunity to participate as a Site Host in the Central Ohio Collaborative AmeriCorps Project (the "Project"), which is sponsored by the Central Ohio Collaborative for Conservation/Franklin Soil and Water Conservation District (the "Collaborative"); and

WHEREAS, the District, wishes to participate in the Project along with other Central Ohio agencies and conservation group, by hosting three full time AmeriCorps member(s) for the period of one year, during the 2025-2026 program year; and

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members will gain a strong background in conservation and education skills and practices and the District will benefit from assistance with natural resources; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement to participate in the Project, the District must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), outlining the responsibilities of the Sponsoring Organization (the Collaborative) and the Host Site (the District); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the MOU, the Host Site is required to provide a local share of funding for the Program, which amounts to a payment of \$11,000.00 per AmeriCorps member; and

WHEREAS, the District deems that participation in the Project furthers the District's goals of conservation and education, and that serving as a Host Site reinforces those goals in Central Ohio,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Board of Park Commissioners hereby authorizes the Executive Director to sign a MOU with the Central Ohio Collaborative for Conservation/FSWCD for the 2025-2026 program year for three AmeriCorps member(s) for a total amount up to \$33,000.00.
