RESOLUTION 2025 - 626

TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SIGN A PURCHASE AGREEMENT, CLOSING DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS TO EXPAND ORCHARD OAKS PRESERVE

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners (the "Board") of the Preservation Park District of Delaware County (the "District") deem it desirable and in the best interests of the District to acquire a portion of parcel numbers 516-300-02-122-000 and 516-300-02-123-000 consisting of approximately 3.7 acres, more or less, in Porter Township, County of Delaware, State of Ohio (the "Property") from Allen and Gillian Blyth to expand Orchard Oaks Preserve upon such terms and conditions included in the purchase agreement for a price of \$130,060.00 plus closing costs; and,

WHEREAS, funds for the purchase of this property are appropriated in Fund 799 – Parks Capital Projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Park Commissioners hereby directs and authorizes the Executive Director, as agent for this Board, to execute all documents required relating to the purchase of the property, including but not limited to a purchase agreement, license agreement, and closing documents, and that any actions taken by the Executive Director prior to the date of this resolution regarding this purchase are within the authority conferred to the Executive Director.
