Responsibilities:

- Learn the internal workings of opening, maintaining, and running a park.
- Perform landscaping maintenance including mowing, trimming, mulching, etc.
- Assist Education department with maintaining the native gardens and entrance beds
- Help maintain clean and safe parks through the upkeep and cleaning of facilities, restrooms, and shelters. Pick up litter and empty receptacles.
- Perform basic trail maintenance including clearing paths, trimming, and pruning.
- Work on maintenance and construction projects.
- Work with other departments and participate in special events.
- Work on Natural Resources projects.
- Work with the Sustainability Team to help reduce the environmental impact of the park district

Minimum Requirements:

- Valid driver's license and evidence of satisfactory driving record for insurability.
- Ability to operate hand, power tools, vehicles, tractors, and mowing equipment.
- General maintenance and mechanical skills.
- General understanding of natural resources and environment.

Benefits:

- Undergraduate or graduate students may receive college credit in this position.
- Seasonal employees participate in the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System.
