- Basic understanding of interpretation or environmental education, dendrology, botany, ecology, geology, entomology, ornithology, and other fields typically required to be a naturalist.

- Have a good work ethic and the ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Valid driver's license and evidence of satisfactory driving record for insurability.
- First aid and CPR certified or ability to become certified.
- Ability to work weekends, evenings, and holidays.
